CANADA'S AFFORDABILITY PLAN



Canada Child Benefit Tax

Tax-free support to families up to \$5,903 per child age 6 through 17; and \$6,997 per child under the age of 6.



Old Age Security

Increases OAS by 10% for seniors aged 75 and older - up to an extra \$766 this year.



Child Care

Cuts child care fees by an average of 50%, saving families up to \$6,000 per child each year.



Canada Workers Benefit

Puts up to \$2,400 more into the pockets of low-income families.



Canada Dental Benefit

Gives parents up-front, direct payments totalling up to \$1,300 per eligible child under 12 to help cover the costs of dental care services.



Canada Summer Jobs

Provides wage subsidies to employers from not-for-profit organizations, the public sector, and private sector, with 50 or fewer employees, for young people aged 15-30.



Federal Student Loan Support

Provides upfront grants, cancels interest on student loans, eliminates student loan payments for grads making less than 40,000 a year.



Climate Action Incentive

Offsets costs from fuel charges with tax-free payments every three months. A family of four will receive up to \$244 each quarter.



Canada Housing Benefit

Offers a one-time tax-free payment of \$500 for lower-income renters.



Canada Greener Homes Initiative

Provides grants and loans for home evaluations and for retrofits, helping homeowners save energy and money.



First-Time Home Buyers

Establishes a tax-free savings account to help save up to \$40,000 for a down payment. Offers up to 10% of purchase price to put toward a down payment, lowering mortgage costs.



Agricultural Clean Technology Program

Two streams of support: Adoption Stream and Research and Innovation Stream - provide access to funding to help develop and adopt clean technologies.



Multi-Generational Home Renovation Tax Credit

One-time tax credit provides a 15% tax refund on home expenses up to \$50,000 to accommodate a family member, to a maximum of \$7,500.



On Farm Climate Action Fund

Provides cost-share funding to farmers to support the implementation of best management practices to tackle climate change through reducing emissions.
